

## **INTERNS REQUIRED FOR THE MENA OFFICE in Cairo – For wide circulation.**

Crisis Action is an international, non-profit organization which aims to help avert conflicts, prevent human rights abuses and ensure governments fulfill their obligations to protect civilians. We work closely with a diverse range of NGO partners to help them increase the impact of their responses to current and emerging conflict-related crises.

We are currently looking for interns who are available to work for the duration of six month starting as soon as possible. We require interns to commit to work full-time for the whole period, as we feel this offers interns the best opportunity to immerse themselves in the organization's work and gain the most valuable experience. Interns act as campaign and research assistants, and are responsible for a range of duties including compiling media updates, attending meetings and drafting notes, liaising with partner organizations and the media, research tasks, and administrative work. In this instance, the intern will work directly under the supervision of the MENA director, and will cover work specifically on Sudan / Darfur issues.

### **Requirements:**

- Excellent written & spoken Arabic / English
- Flexibility & willingness to learn
- An interest in Human Rights and / International Development
- An interest in Middle East issues

The internship is unpaid, but all expenses relevant to work will be paid (travel expenses to/from the office, lunch allowance...etc). This is considered to be a fantastic opportunity to contribute to issues of international development and get some regional experience in the MENA region.
